Vacation Bible School - Important Information

(Registration is Closed)

We are excited to host another amazing Vacation Bible School at Good Shepherd! Each year, nearly 150 children get to experience the love of Jesus through music, Bible stories, games, crafts, and movies. Children also enjoy fun snacks and fun surprises throughout the week. Our theme this year is **SCUBA: Diving into Friendship with God**. VBS is June 10 - 14 from 9:00 a.m. - 12:00 noon.

Important Information for CHILDREN who are Registered:

- We will begin and end each day in Munds Hall Auditorium this year. Because of the pipe organ installation, we will not be able to use the sanctuary. You will need to bring your child to Munds Hall (through the pergola entrance) each day and check them in and out.
- On the first day of VBS, we will have check-in tables set up in the pergola area outside of Munds Hall. Please check in your child and then walk them into Munds Hall Auditorium to find their group. First day check-in will begin at 8:30 a.m. in the pergola area. (Please do not bring children before 8:30.) T-shirts and a card to download the music will be given out at check-in.
- Your child should come dressed comfortably each day and wear tennis shoes. (Tennis shoes are best for playing games and also for playing on the playground, which is where snack time will be held this year.) The VBS t-shirt can be worn whenever they would like.
- **Do not send water bottles with your children.** They get lost and counselors are not able to carry all of them for the children. Water stations will be provided at various locations.
- **Drop off each day after the first day is at 9:00 a.m.** Please <u>do not</u> drop off children before 8:45 a.m. There will not be enough supervision before that time.
- Pick-up each day is promptly at 12:00 noon in Munds Hall Auditorium. Please be on time.

Important COUNSELOR Information:

We have a great group of counselors signed up to help at VBS! Fifth graders will run snack time on the playground this year (we have tents for shade) and 6th - 12th graders will travel to each activity with a group of children.

Training: Counselors will go through a brief training Monday morning at 8:00 a.m. in Dobbins Hall Adult Classroom (next to Munds Hall Auditorium). It is very important to attend this training. Donuts and kolaches will be provided and t-shirts will be given out.

Counselors will need to arrive at 8:30 a.m. each day after the first and check in in DHAC.


Important ADULT VOLUNTEER Information:
